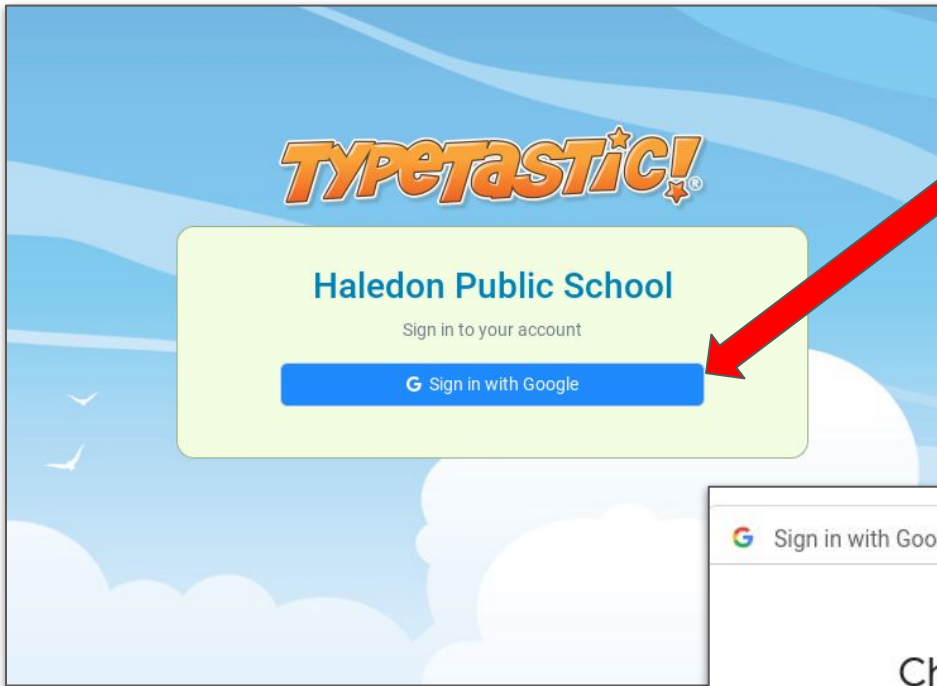

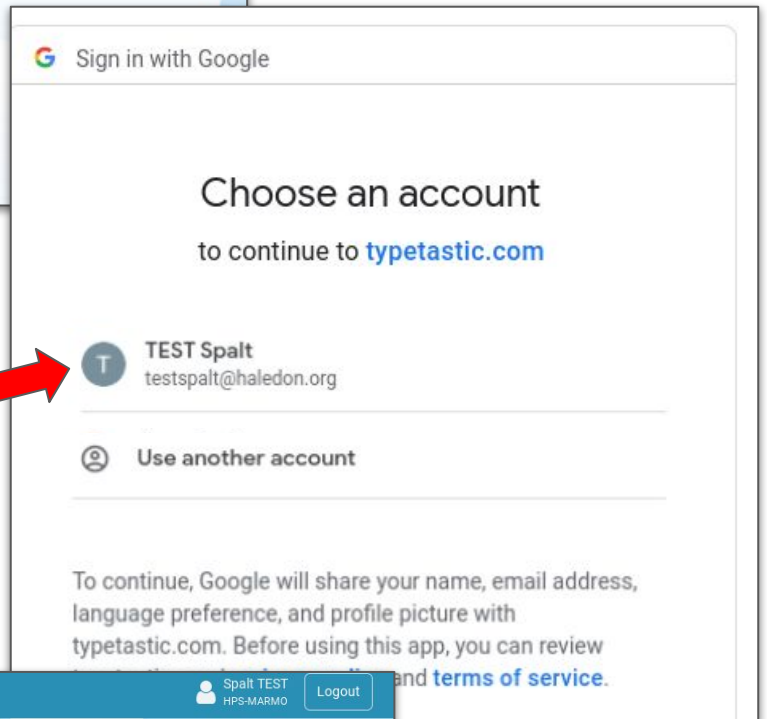

How To Access Typetastic Lessons

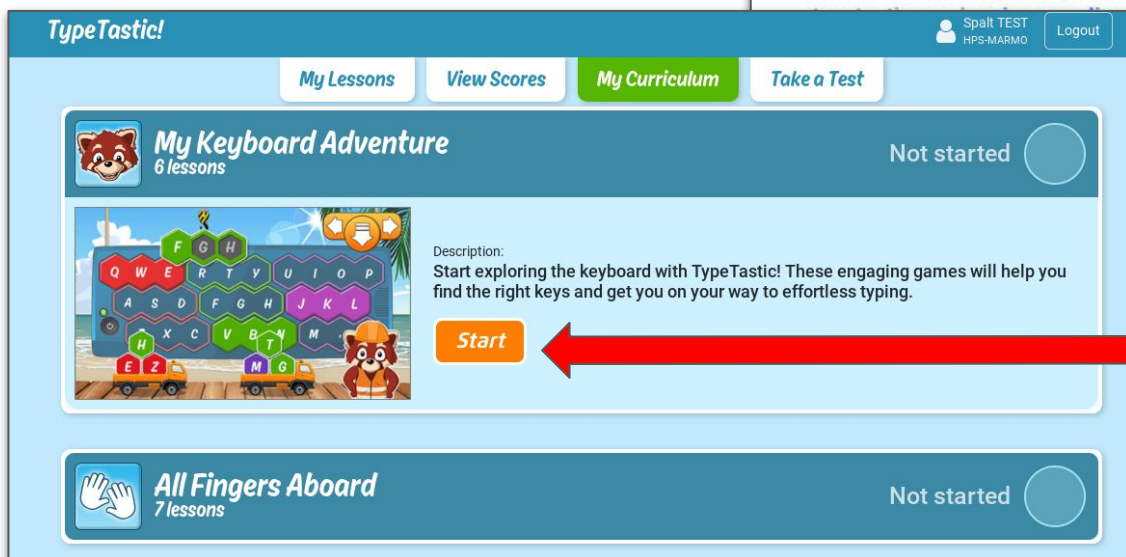
